A. CANDIDATE CRITERIA

- 1. The candidate must have been awarded a Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree not exceeding five (5) years from the date of graduation when the application is submitted.
- 2. Possess good academic merit and research output in the last three (3) years.
 - a. At least three (3) publications as First Author in an indexed journal in Web of Science (Science candidates) or Scopus (Non-Science candidates) including one (1) publication in Q1/Q2 (Journal Citation Report (JCR) and not in SCImago Journal Rank (SJR)).
- 3. The field/ area of the post-doctoral candidate must be matched to the area of the identified supervisor from the respective School/ Centre of Excellence.
- 4. Must report for duty no later than <u>1 SEPTEMBER 2022</u>.
- 5. Preference will be given to candidates who are Malaysian citizens.

B. SUPERVISOR CRITERIA

- 1. Must be a permanent academic staff who has been confirmed in the position;
- 2. Possess good academic and research output in the last three (3) years:
 - a. At least three (3) publications as First Author/ Corresponding Author in Web of Science (Science field) or Scopus (Non-Science field) including one (1) publication in Q1/Q2.
- 3. Active in research, publication and supervision;
- 4. Active as a researcher in the last five (5) years;
- 5. Has an active external grant as principal researcher and must be active for at least one (1) year from the date of application;
- 6. Has graduated Ph.D. student(s) as Main Supervisor (at least one (1) Ph.D. student); and
- 7. Those who have been approved for Sabbatical Leave are not eligible to supervise a Post-Doctoral Fellow.

C. RESEARCH PLAN

- Priority of research related to existing research fields at USM.
 Post-Doctoral Fellow will not be involved in any teaching activities.
 Related to the supervisor's research grant.
 Priority will be given to research areas within the 10-10 Malaysia Science, Technology, Innovation and Economy (MySTIE) Framework. Please refer to the Appendix for more information on these areas.

D. PERIOD OF APPOINTMENT

- 1. The term of appointment is for one (1) year and may be considered for reappointment based on the achievements of the FPD.
- 2. The maximum appointment period is for two (2) years only.

E. BENEFITS

- 1. An honorarium of RM5,500.00 per month (before tax deductions or STD) under USM;
- 2. Eligible to receive own medical care only at the Pusat Sejahtera/ IPPT Clinic/ USM Hospital (HUSM) only. The fellow must bear the cost of examination treatment for further/ periodic/ follow-up treatment;
- 3. Eligible up to fourteen (14) days of annual leave and seven (7) days Sick Leave during he appointment period. Not eligible to apply for other leave;
- 4. Not eligible for insurance coverage (Fellow is advised to obtain their own health insurance);
- 5. Not eligible for Cash Award in lieu of accumulated leave (AWT);
- 6. Not eligible for inward/outward passage assistance;
- 7. No deduction to Employees Provident Fund (EPF);
- 8. All costs related not limited to charges for quarantine/ detection test (swab test)/ medical and other related COVID-19 charges for candidates entering Malaysia will not be borne by the University.

F. KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATOR (KPI)

- 1. Post-Doctoral Fellow
 - a. Produce **three (3) publications** as **First Author** in an indexed journal in Web of Science (Science candidates) or Scopus (Non-Science candidates) during the period of appointment as Post-Doctoral Fellow at USM including **two (2)** publications in **Q1/Q2** (based on JCR and not in SJR) within one (1) year.
- 2. Supervisor
 - a. The **Post-Doctoral Fellow's publications KPIs** will be **considered as additional KPIs** to the existing KPIs of the Supervisor as set by the University under the criteria for perfomance appraisal of academic staff (M1 Research and Publications).
- 3. Achievement of the stated Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) is the main criteria for evaluation and consideration for re-appointment applications (if any).

G. HOW TO APPLY


- Application using the Post-Doctoral Fellow form (<u>http://www.research.usm.my/default.asp?tag=17</u>)
- 2. All completed applications must be submitted and endorsed by:

- 3. Successful candidates must report for duty no later than <u>1 SEPTEMBER 2022.</u> If they fail to report for duty on the stated date, the applicant is considered to have declined the offer.
